

COVID-19 Recovery AmeriCorps has positions available in Iowa City and Coralville!

One of these part-time positions might be a great fit while also completing your studies.

Coralville Community Food Pantry: Support food pantry and home delivery programs, strengthen the community fridge at the public library, increase engagement with school age programming for school break and summer feeding programs.

• 1 part-time position (full time also available)

CommUnity Crisis Services & Food Bank: Support the food warehouse, mobile pantry and home delivery programs or serve with the critical needs staff to provide basic needs and referrals to clients.

• 3 part-time positions (full time also available)

National Alliance on Mental Illness Johnson County: Support volunteer recruitment and management and enhance NAMI Signature Programs through development of hybrid program options and best practices.

• 1 part-time position

Part Time Requirements: Serve 675 hours over 36 weeks (20 hours per week) **Benefits**: \$7,623 living allowance (\$423 every 2 weeks) and after a successful term of service AmeriCorps members earn a \$2,474 education award.

AmeriCorps Eligibility: 18 years or older, HS diploma or GED, US citizen, US national or permanent legal resident, and pass background checks

With a little modification, this can qualify for the JMC:3700 Nonprofit Internship course!

These are all direct service (programmatic) opportunities where AmeriCorps members are supporting the activities of the host site. AmeriCorps members gain experience interacting with clients or volunteers, providing or recommending community resources, assisting with inventory/donation intake and distribution, training and assisting volunteers, and organizing logistics. Additional activities like social media content creation or creating resources for clients to better utilize the services (recipe cards, updated resource guides) may also be available.
